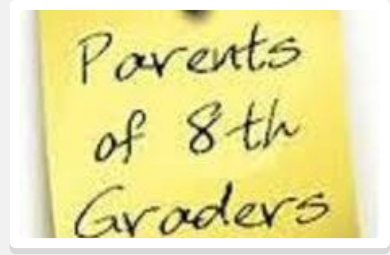
FRIDAY E-DAY
